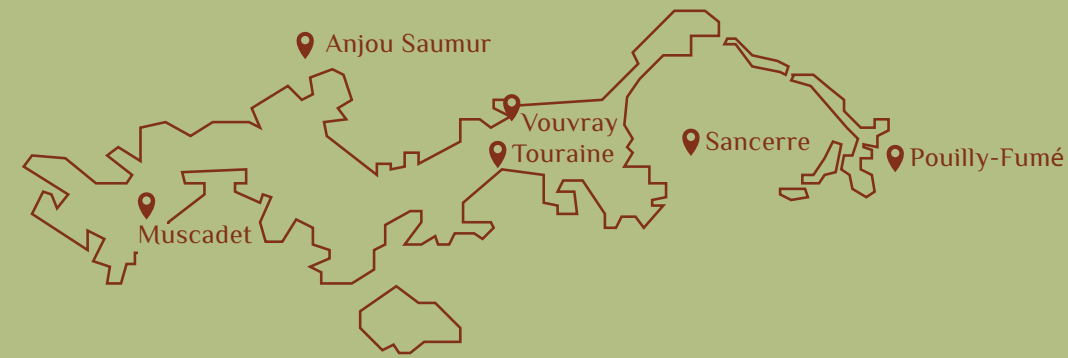

FRANCE LOIRE & ALSACE

The 600 miles stretch of Loire valley and its tributaries make up one of France's top wine regions. The classification systems in the Loire Valley dictate what grapes are planted here. Major renowned classifications are Sancerre, Touraine, Anjou and Saumur.

The major varieties of grapes grown are Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc, Muscadet, Chardonnay and Pinot Gris.

Alsace is situated in far north-east part of France. It has 3 appellations like Alsace, Alsace grand cru and Cremant d'Alsace for sparkling wines. Grape varieties produced are Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc & Muscat.

FRANCE BURGUNDY

Burgundy is a historic and highly respected wine region in France. Two key grape varieties grown are Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. It is divided into Côte d'Or which comprises of Côte de Nuits & Côte de Beaune, Côte Chalonnaise and Mâconnais.

Chablis situated in an isolated pocket of limestone hills in north-western Burgundy, produces white wines so distinct in style from those of central Burgundy that it is often treated as a region in its own right. The Burgundian climate is predominantly continental, with relatively short summers and cool winters.

FRANCE SOUTHERN FRANCE

The southern region of France has notable wine regions such as Bordeaux, Languedoc-Roussillon, Provence and Rhone valley. They enjoy maritime climate with courtesy of Atlantic ocean. The soil ranges from sand, clay and gravel.

Major grape varieties for white wines are Sauvignon Blanc, Picpoul de Pinet, Roussane, Marsanne, Viognier, Chardonnay and Semillon.

ITALY

Italy is known for their dry whites. It has 20 main regions which produce elegant white wines. Some of the noted regions are Tuscany, Piedmont, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Veneto, Campania and Marche. One of the most common and appreciated variety is Pinot Grigio. However they also produce unique varieties like Verdicchio, Malvasia, Trebbiano, Arnie, Grechetto, etc. It also produced international varieties like Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Gewurztraminer.

SPAIN

Spain has a history of producing wines for more than 3000 years with the largest vineyard area producing 600 grape varieties. However, only 20 varieties are used to produce the wines. For white wines, Airén variety is mostly used but the most famous for quality are Verdejo and Albariño.



AUSTRIA

Austria has 3 main wine regions, Niederoesterreich (lower Austria), Burgenland and Steiermark. Notable sub-regions are Wachau, Kremstal and Kamptal. Main white wine grapes produced are Gruener Veltliner and Riesling.

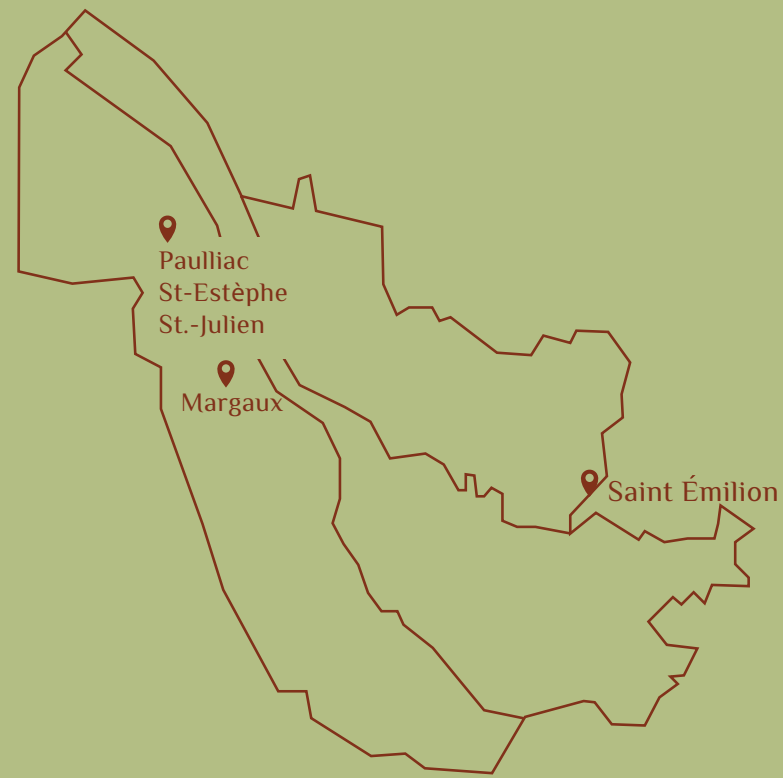

FRANCE BURGUNDY

Burgundy wine region stretches almost 300km. It consists of 5 main vineyards from north to south which are Chablis, Côte de Nuits, Côte de Beaune, Côte Chalonnaise & Mâconnais. Main red grape variety is Pinot Noir. It has 4 classifications: Grand Cru 1%, Premier Cru 10%, Village wine 37% and Regional wine 52%.

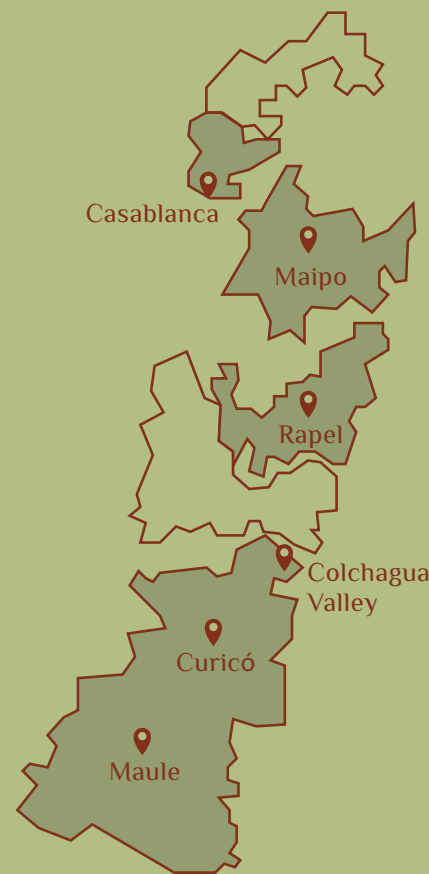

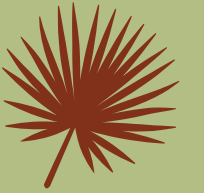

Rose Wine

It is actually the oldest type of wine ever made. Rose wine is made with red wine grapes, in a similar manner to red wine but with reduced time fermenting the grape skins. The reduced skin contact gives the desired pink colour and a lighter flavour than of a red wine.

It is typically blended with variety of different wine grapes. It can be also single varietal wine made from only one type of grape. The common grape 37 varieties to produce a rose wine are Syrah, Cinsault, Mourvedre, Tibouren, Carignan, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Sauvignon.

Dessert Wine

They are typically wines which are enjoyed along with the dessert course. Dessert wines range in various categories like sparkling, lightly sweet, richly sweet, sweet red and fortified wine.

There are different styles of dessert wines like late harvest, noble rot, ice wine and dried grape. They are produced by both white and red grapes. Notable countries that produce quality wines are France, Italy, Hungary, Canada and New Zealand.
